

Assembly Instructions

CALISTOGA FIRE TABLE

Tools Needed

Cordless Drill

6" #2 Square Drive Bit

Tape Measure

5/32" Allen Wrench



STEP 1: (a) Lay all pieces on a smooth soft surface such as cardboard or carpet to help avoid scratching. We suggest using a 6" #2 square drive bit to fasten all screws (available at your local hardware store). **Be careful to not over tighten any of the fasteners.**

STEP 2: (b) Place one of the long side assemblies on a clean soft surface with the back side facing up and fasten the tank shelf to the side by lining up the bottom of the shelf with the bottom of the bottom stile and 3" back from the end with the 5/16" hole in it using the 1 1/2" stainless steel round head screws provided. (c) Fasten the 3/4 x 1 3/4" stile to the side assembly in the mortise using the 1 1/2" stainless steel round head screws provided making sure that the T-nut is on the back side and at the bottom. (d) Fasten the end panel, **without the through holes in it**, to the end furthest away from the shelf by lining it up with the end of the side panel and the bottom of the side leg by using the 1 1/2" stainless steel round head screws provided. Place the other long side assembly on a clean soft surface with the back side up and repeat the previous steps.

STEP 3: (e) Place the table top on a clean soft surface with the bottom side up and center the completed base assembly upside down on the bottom of the table top. (f) Fasten the base assembly to the table top using the 5/8" stainless steel round head screws provided through the metal brackets. (g) Place the table on its feet and secure the tank access by using the 2 1/2" wafer head stainless steel lags provided. (h) Insert the thumb screws in to the predrilled holes in the tank access door to secure the door. **Install burner per the instructions provided with the burner.**
